

Creating a Safe, Positive, Nurturing, Focused Learning Environment

Our school family uses

Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS)
to ensure that we create safe, positive,
nurturing, focused learning.

This system includes:

Clear school-wide behavior expectations that are based upon mutual respect for each other and the learning environment.

Electronic Devices

We encourage students to leave ALL electronic devices at HOME!!

Devices, including cell phones, must be <u>OFF and OUT OF SIGHT</u> THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL DAY.

Dress Code

Students shall not wear the following items:

Clothing that exposes the midriff, navel, or cleavage.

Clothing, pins, jewelry, accessories, or other items of adornment displaying obscene, profane, derogatory, violent or gang-related messages, themes, designs or pictures.

Tank tops, halter tops, garments with spaghetti straps, tube tops, fishnet tops, strapless dresses or other clothing that is not appropriate because of slits, rips or holes in the garment.

Jeans or Pants with holes above the knee. Skirts or shorts that are not fingertip length.

Arrival at School

Students may enter the building beginning at 7:45am.

All students are subject to a search upon entering the building.

Students who arrive by bus will enter from the Bus Ramp and proceed to the cafeteria (to eat breakfast) or to their classroom (if they choose not to eat).

Students who arrive by car will be dropped off in the front of of the school next to the "drop off" sign and enter the building in the front, then proceed to either the cafeteria or their classroom.

Students who walk to school will enter the school in the front of the building.
